Letter from the PRESIDENT



This year has been exceptionally challenging for all of us. We depend upon Allah (swt) and our donors for support. However, everyone has been impacted by this situation. We pray for your health, your family, and ease from any difficulties experienced this year.

Due to this, we had to scale back on some of our operations and work overseas. We concentrated our efforts exclusively in the Horn of Africa and East Africa where there was the most need.

The pandemic impacted the region that already had a limited healthcare system and resources. There was flooding in Beledweyne while other regions suffered from

a lack of rain. With security and conflict in other regions, there were difficulties many times to get the aid needed. **2.7** million people in Somalia are still dealing with food insecurity. **840,000** children are malnourished. With your support, we can try to bridge that gap. **8** out of **10** people do not have access to water. In **2020**, we built **258** water wells and **2** borehole wells.

Among our many projects in the region, we completed a mother/child clinic, a school, and a borehole water well in the Kahda region in the largest IDP camp. **85,000** families now have access to these facilities. The borehole will reduce the cost of trucking water to them.

Amoud Foundation recognizes and appreciates our donors, staff, and volunteers wholeheartedly for supporting us and being a part of this cause. Our 2021 goals will, in shaa Allah, focus on saving lives, preventing loss of life, sustainable projects in food production, and opening vocational schools. We look forward to your continued investment in Amoud and in contributing to making a difference in the lives of our most vulnerable brothers and sisters in need. We look forward to 2021.

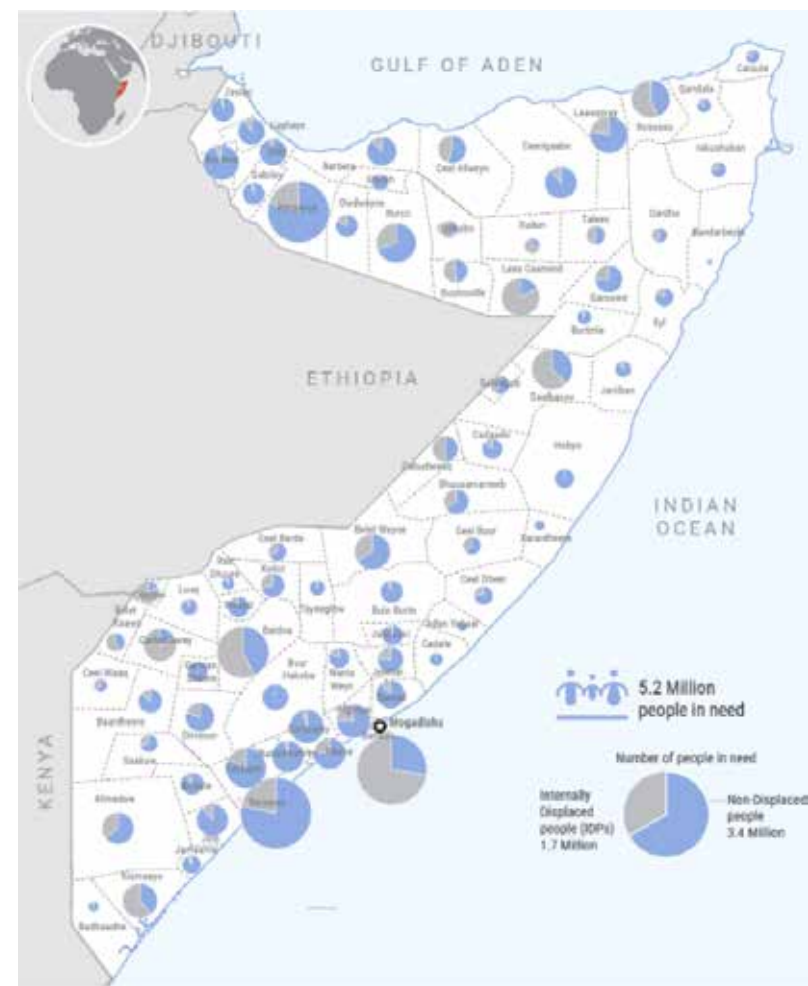
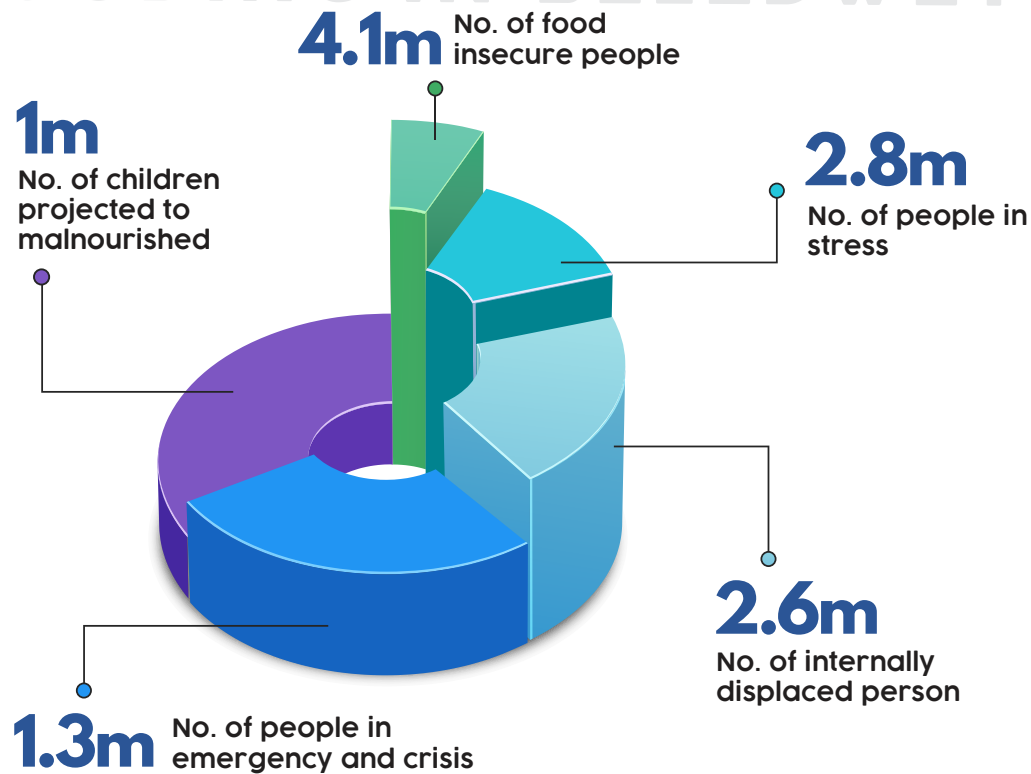

Education is undoubtedly a source of empowerment and development for both individuals and the society. Achieving development goals in any society depends on women's participation in education. Being a student and a mother at the same time is extremely difficult in this time. Nimco Aden Muse is one of women that is facing these challenges with three children, but the most important thing is she has patience and good intentions in learning under these circumstances.

She has the responsibility to raise three children and to take care of the home and also to take care of her education at the same time. Her life is completely different than those around her. Nimco gets support from her husband, a local farmer, who is always there for her to give her motivation to finish her education successfully. The road has been rough and they are still holding on together. Nimco is **20** years old now, she got married when she was **17** years at the first class of the secondary (Batch **2017**). She lives with her mother-in-law and her husband.

Her mother-in-law and sister in-law help her to take care of the children while she is learning. Sometimes she misses the school for weeks because of a lack of babysitter. Nimco did not get any support from any other side of her society. Nimco's husband works on a small farm which is the only source of income for her and her family. The farm her husband worked on was affected by the recurrent drought and the Sagar Cyclone.

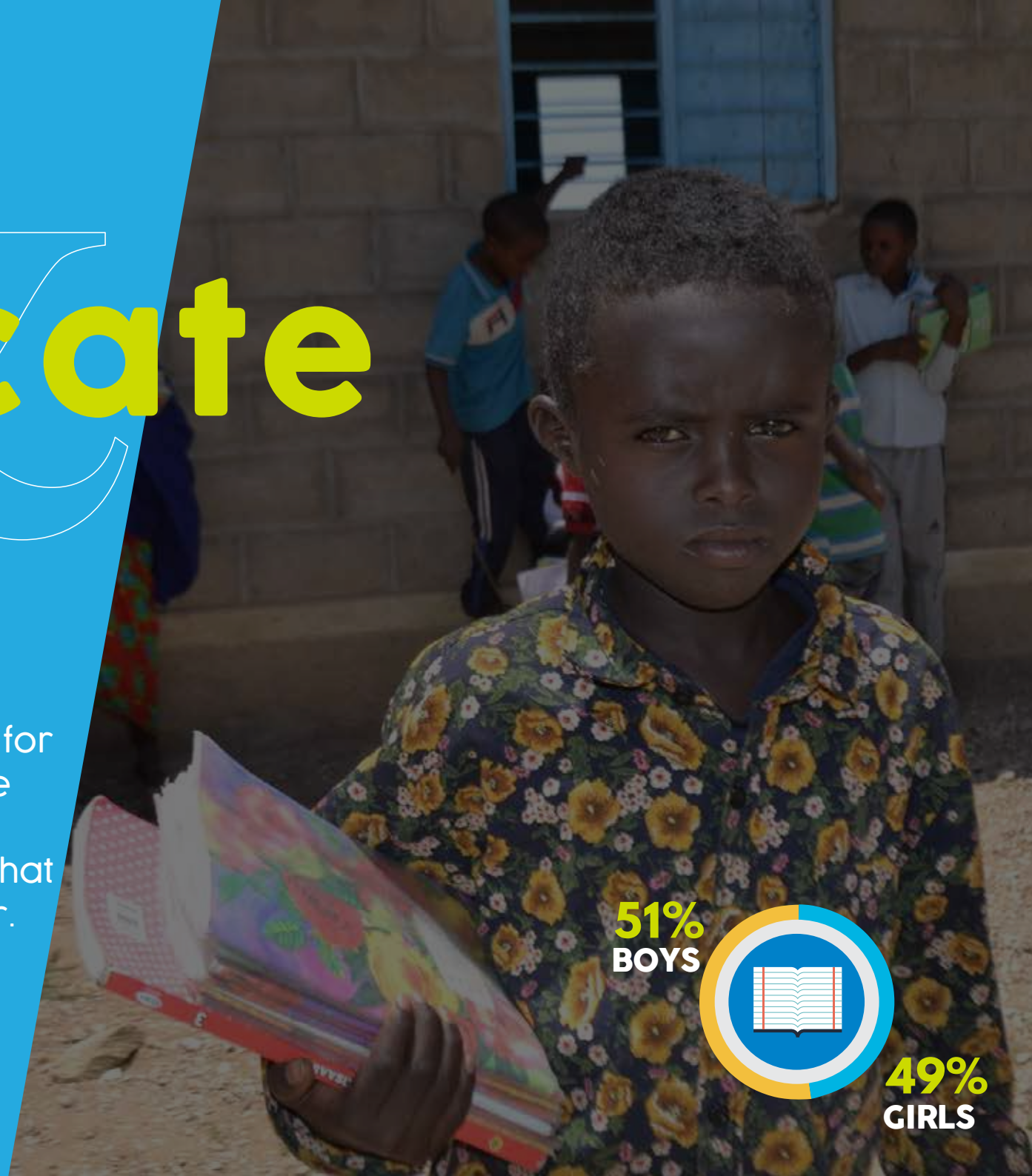

Independent Accountant's Audit AUDIT REPORT ▼

To the Board of Directors of Amoud Foundation:

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Amoud Foundation (a nonprofit organization) which comprise of the statement of financial position as of December 31, 2019, and the related statements of activities and cash flow for the year then ended.

MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Amoud Foundation as of December 31, 2019, and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the year then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.
