## Letter from the PRESIDENT

Amoud for Relief and Development has been helping people in the Horn of Africa since 1998. We have accomplished many missions due to the generosity of our donors and the dedication of our volunteers and staff. There is still a significant amount of work to be done as the need is so dire and pervasive.

8 out of 10 people have no access to water in the Horn of Africa. Girls and mothers are at the forefront, having to walk great distances to obtain fresh water. Thanks to our generous donors, we completed 236 water wells in 2019 as well as sending water trucks to the IDPs.

A devastating flood hit the Central Somalia and Shabela region leaving thousands in need of supplies. Amoud responded by providing dry food packages and shelters.

There are over 182 IDP camps in Banadir with no schools, health posts, or running water. We started a medical center, school, and are ready to begin drilling a bore hole water well that can accommodate the 85,000 families in the Kahda Town. We could not have done this without the support of our donors.

As a result of our commitment and transparency to our donors, we have earned the rating as a 4-star charity on Charity Navigator. We have also welcomed a new Executive Director, Issam Abdallah, who brings years of experience in the non-profit sector.



Amoud recognizes and appreciates our donors, volunteers, and staff wholeheartedly for being a part of this cause. We look forward to providing more assistance and support in 2020.

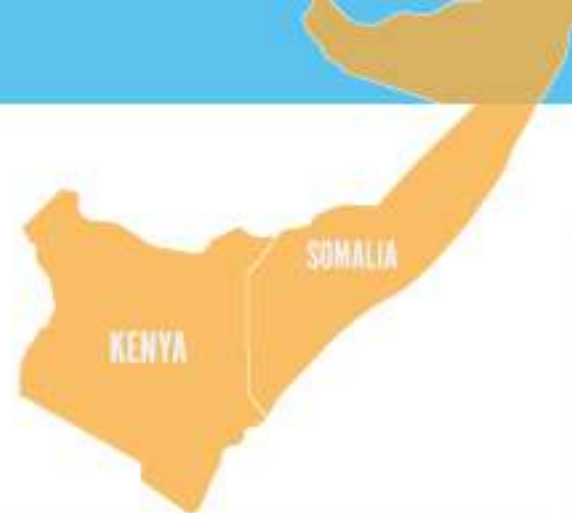

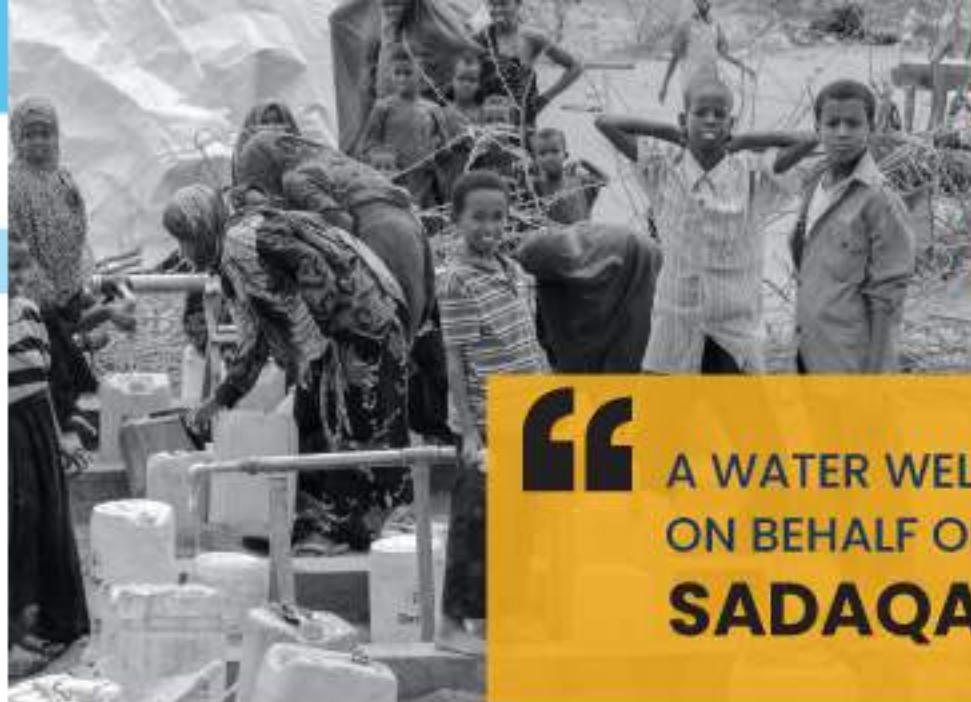

**11 Mother Child Healthcare Centers** established since 2014.

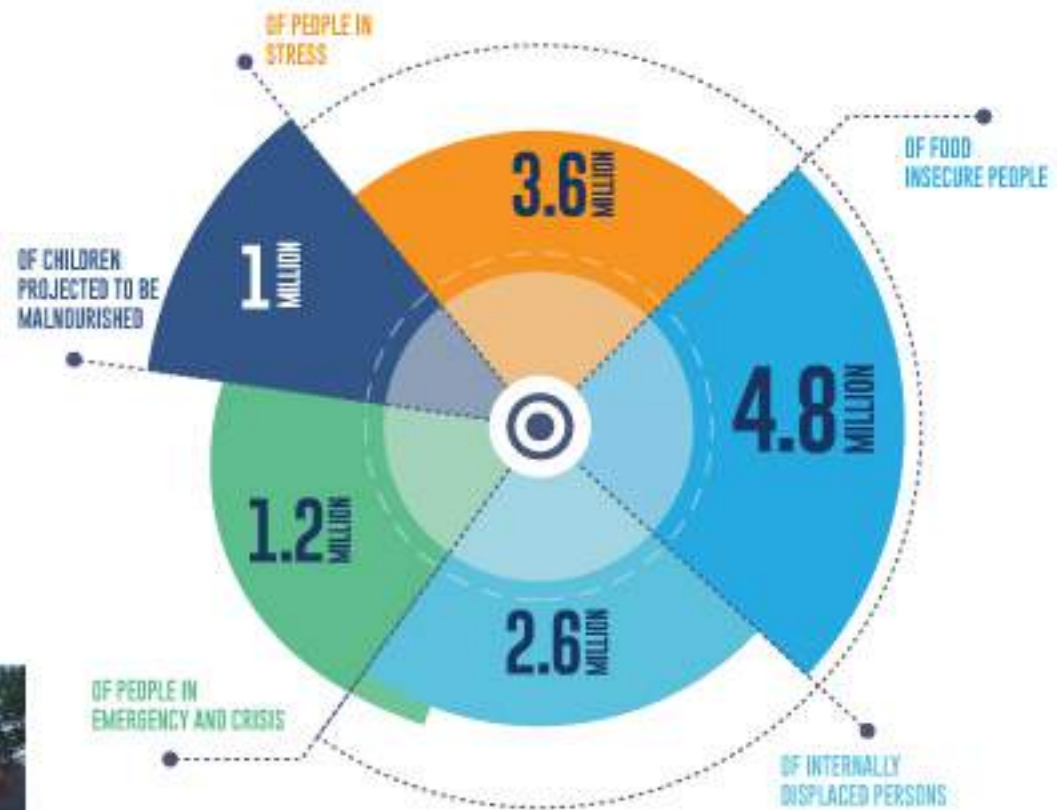
## **MCH: 85,000 FAMILIES IN THE AREA**

Amoud is first organization to build a healthcare facility in the area. Women had to give birth in the bathrooms before.

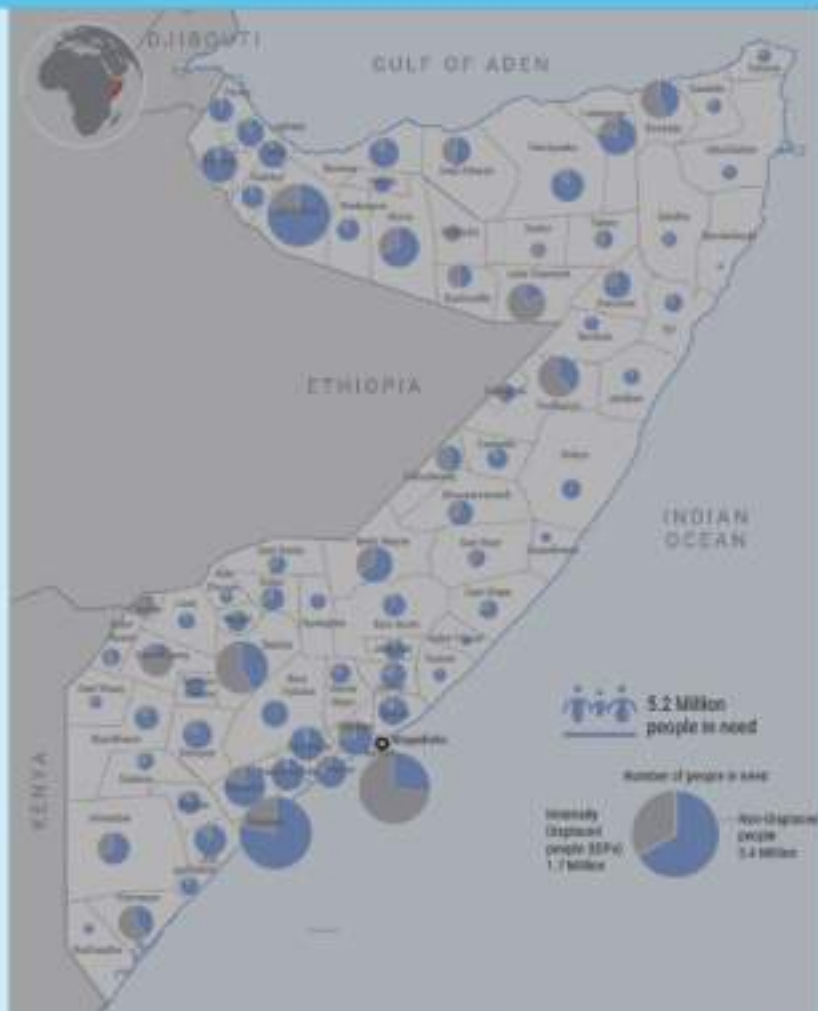

The children also receive a new gift for Eid each year.

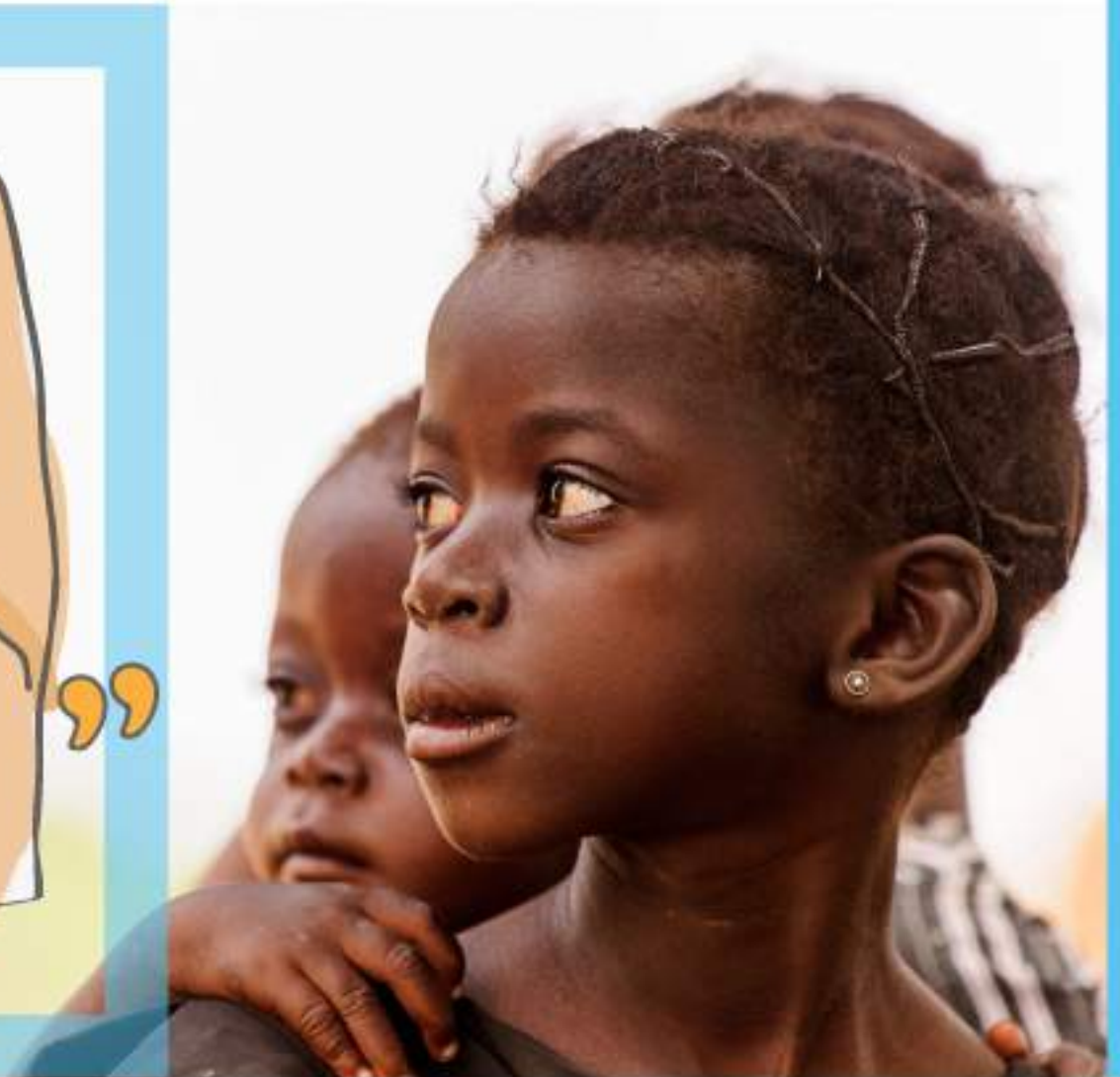

# Independent Accountant's Audit AUDIT REPORT

## To the Board of Directors of Amoud Foundation:

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Amoud Foundation (a nonprofit organization) which comprise of the statement of financial position as of December 31, 2019, and the related statements of activities and cash flow for the year then ended.

### MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Amoud Foundation as of December 31, 2019, and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the year then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.
